Rapid Recap: SBC Flying the Flag

Silverstream Bowling Club was represented by Leighton Wilding and Daniel Welch at the final of six Regional Qualifiers for the Indoor 20K. The Wellington qualifier was held at Naenae Bowling Club on July 19.

Leighton picked up one win from four matches, with his three losses all going to tiebreaker ends — each decided by a single point.

Daniel started strong with two solid wins, leading the field at lunch. Two close losses in the afternoon saw Daniel finish mid-table.

The overall winner of the Indoor 20K was Lisa White, one of six invited players from across New Zealand and Australia. She claimed the \$10,000 winner's cheque after an impressive run that included wins over top Australian bowlers Corey Wedlock and Aaron Wilson.

The week before, Lisa also took out the NZ Women's Champion of Champions Singles title, defeating our own Clare Hendra 21–11 in the quarter-finals. Well done to Clare on her awesome achievement against another of the country's top players — a great effort at the national level.
