## Rapid Recap: Dynasty Interclub Rounds 1 & 2

A great start for Silverstream across the Interclub grades.

Men's Division 2 opened with a 14-7 win over last year's Div 3 champs Whitby, then swept Stokes Valley in style. They sit second on the table, just a point behind Island Bay.

Men's Division 4 had two wins from three against Wilton and a clean sweep over Upper Hutt, putting them firmly on top of their table.

Women's Division 1 had a strong start against Miramar with two wins and a bonus point for a narrow fours loss.

Johnsonville proved tough in the afternoon, taking all three matches and showing early signs of being the team to beat.

After Victoria's default, the Div 5 took 21 points in Round 1, then added a 21-9 singles win and pairs victory over Plimmerton in the PM. They're sitting third equal.

The Mixed Quad managed one win so far, but with only 14 points between top and bottom, there's plenty of time to climb once play resumes after their round 3 bye.
